"Hopefully, still happy and healthy. And married - maybe with a family. Who knows what will come my way."

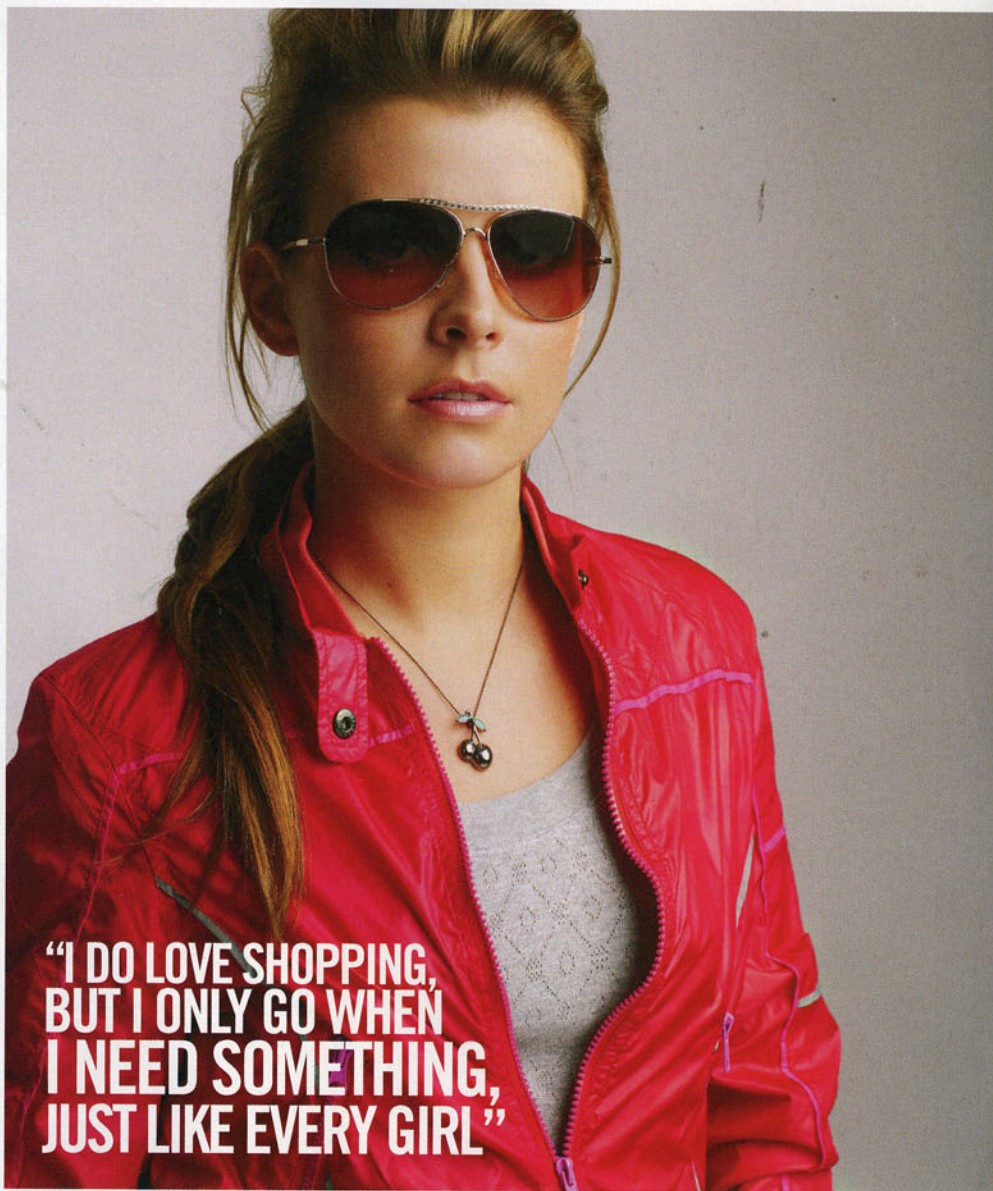
So have you set a date for the wedding?
